Who We Are:

Write For You Productions is a business established so all children can reach their true potential. The program will benefit low-income children. WFYP is a professional company that researches, develops, and writes curriculum for a new patent pending preschool learning anti-bully program which contains the new patent pending steps to early learning. Michele Lucien Erickson is a business owner for Write For You Productions. Her responsibilities included successfully developing a franchise opportunity for Fisher Broadcasting while working for Patrick C. Scott, CEO and was also promoted by Phelps Fisher, one of the owners of Fisher Companies; her duties as Division Head also included, but were not limited to, developing and maintaining websites, selling sponsorships, developing new business partnerships, setting up new strategic online

distribution, including online sales and producing a relocation documentary television program. He held a 3.96 G.P.A. while being a part of the Varsity Basketball and Drama Teams, as well as playing Babe Ruth Baseball and working at Arby's Restaurant and later a Caddy at Inglemoor Golf Club. The caddy position was a two-year commitment. Phi is a recipient of The High School Achievement Award. Phil was awarded a Presidential Nomination and graduated from the Naval Academy. He majored in Computer Science, and was in the top ten percentile; he was and still is an outstanding leader. The impact Phil made at Annapolis stuck with his fellow students' parents twenty years later.

Phil was an F-18 Flight Instructor, he flew T-2's, T-4's, A-7's, and F-18's. He's classified status, which included Fighter Strike Weapon School, organizing an entire legal library, a Military Legal Officer; writing tickets and counseling young and old alike with a high level of success. Lt. Erickson was top 10% of his class in Flight School and had the top landing grades in his fleet airwing for multiple exercises. Phil owned Erickson Aviation, a touring company in Seattle, WA.
